Nipa Huts

Ladies / Gentlemen,

Please be advised that delivery of new nipa huts will no longer be allowed effective December 1, 2015 for the following reasons:

- 1. Fire hazard (smoking, cooking, dry spells)
- 2. Flying parts during typhoons
- 3. Eyesores (dilapidated units)
- 4. Setback violations









For companies that already have deployed nipa huts installed, we will allow these units to stay on with the following conditions:

- 1. Nipa Huts must be securely anchored to the ground
- 2. Fire extinguishers must be placed right beside the Nipa Hut
- 3. All Nipa Huts should be non-smoking and non-cooking areas
- 4. All Nipa Huts must be located beyond the restricted setback zones as defined in the FPIP Deed of Restrictions Article IV Section 1
- 5. Refurbishing of Nipa Huts already on site will not be allowed; Dilapidated Nipa Huts must be hauled out of the Park and may not be replaced

Non-complying structures shall be deemed as illegal structures and must be removed from the Locator's premises and the Park.
